Real ID deadline extended to 2025

Just five months before the latest Real ID deadline, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security has again extended when travelers will need to have a federally mandated identification card for domestic flights.

The federal agency said it would push back the deadline to May 5, 2025, two years after the most recent May 3, 2023, deadline.

New York has three types of identification: A standard driver's license, an Enhanced ID, and Real ID. Both an Enhanced ID and a Real ID will allow you to fly anywhere in the U.S., while a standard driver's license will not.





Arise & Ski is a program offered by Arise Inc. (https://www.ariseinc.org/), designed to give the disabled community an opportunity to learn to ski in a safe and supportive environment. The program was first launched in 1996 at Toggenburg Mountain, and upon the closing of that facility the program moved to Labrador Mountain, where we are today.



Volunteer instructors are needed every year, and skiers with intermediate to advanced skillsets willing to learn how to work with our students are very much appreciated. There are 4 sessions each weekend, (Sat AM & PM, Sun AM & PM) for 6 weekends starting this Saturday the 7th. Volunteers sign up for the season, typically for one or two regular weekend days \ time slots (i.e. "every Saturday morning for the 6 weeks).


