**FLSC is headed to the Poconos to bike the D&L Rail Trail
along the scenic Lehigh River in Jim Thorpe, PA!
Sun, July 9 – Tues, July 11, 2023
\$260 (plus tax) per person, double occupancy**



This “drive yourself” (3 hours from Auburn) trip includes:

- Two nights at The Inn at Jim Thorpe –2 blocks from the bike shop and starting point
 - (10 rooms held for 20 people)
- 2 queen beds
- \$10 voucher for breakfast each morning at the Broadway Grille in the hotel
- Bike storage either at the bike shop or hotel
- Free off-street parking and free Wi-Fi in the rooms
- Shuttle each day to a different starting point of the D&L trail. Bike back to Jim Thorpe
 - Arrive at bike shop by 9:15 am for 9:30 am shuttle
 - Various bike rental options are available or bring your own

We need a **minimum of 8 people** to run this trip. These dates are reserved for our group. Check in to the hotel Sunday afternoon, bike Monday and Tuesday. Looking for a change from the Erie Canal and biking back and forth to our cars that we have been doing? This is it.

Day 1: Full Lehigh Gorge - 25 miles

Day 2: Lehigh Gap - 21 miles

We are planning a 2 day leisurely bike trip on the D&L Rail Trail which runs along the picturesque Lehigh River. Please bring helmets, replacement tubes/patch kits, snacks/lunch and water for each day. We will stop along the way for a picnic lunch. Jim Thorpe is a quaint walking town with restaurants, shopping, trolley tours, pubs and wineries.

\$100 deposit at booking. Balance due by June 9th. This is a book yourself trip. Call Pocono Biking directly at 570-325-8430, ask for Debbie. Let Elaine know you are coming! Full refund if canceled more than 10 days prior to July 9th. If canceled within 10 days you will receive a digital raincheck good this year or next. Rain or shine (will receive a voucher for the value of shuttle for this year or next if it rains one day).

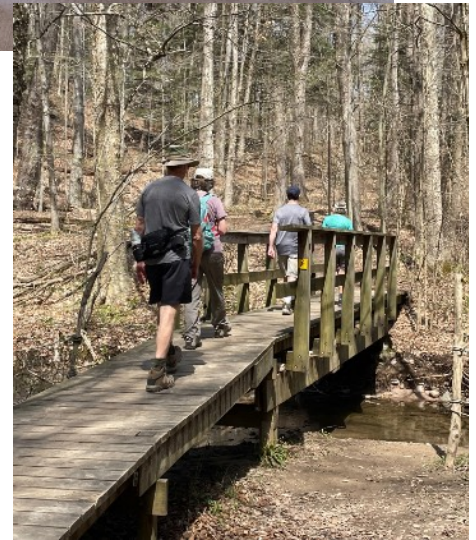
