



On another note, my name has been impersonated in an email requesting electronic gift cards for the ski club. Be aware this is phishing of course. And if anyone needs more awareness, please check out an education site about phishing attacks.

And speaking of education, I recently listened to a talk given by a geology professor about the Finger Lakes. Did you know that Cayuga and Seneca Lakes are among the deepest in the US? Both have bottom depths that are well below sea level. Cayuga is also the longest but Seneca Lake is the largest by volume. And research has shown that HABs are linked to the rotting weeds along the shorelines. So there are efforts now to clean up the debris to control these blooms which usually occur early to mid-August. It is strongly advised to never swim in a bloom area due to toxins that are released. The affected area will sometimes clear after waiting 2 - 3 hours.

So enjoy your water sports & activities safely during this month!
