The 2023 FLSC-OSC Road Rally A Success!

We started out with 28 cars at Song Mountain and, although three cars had to drop out due to a variety of causes, we ended up with almost 80 people at TRAX in Greek Peak.

(Greek Peak's mountain biking season is over. TRAX was open just for us and, listening to their staff talk afterward, it turned out to be their busiest Sunday since the end of ski season.)

The 40+ mile route was not the typical "Sunday drive", with three sections of unpaved roads and some paved roads where driving along them felt like you were in another country.

There were 40 questions and the first place team, headed by driver Lauri

Heath, was the only one to get all of the correct answers. The Scolaro team came in second, with one wrong answer, and third place was a tie between the Clements and Cooper teams, with two wrong answers. There were five teams that tied for fifth place with three missed questions.

Bob Sloan and I owe a debt of gratitude to Jan Carr, who drove the route along with Carol Adamec, for checking our directions and suggesting some clarifications.

We've started thinking about next year, but it's hasn't been easy to find a restaurant that can handle 80 people wandering in on a Sunday afternoon. Also, we have to find some more obscure questions!



2024 WHISTLER, BC SKI TRIP Sat, January 27 – Sat, February 3, 2024 \$1,380 per person (does NOT include lift tickets) DEADLINE to sign up = Tues, October 10!



The Finger Lakes Ski Club is finally going to Whistler/Blackcomb in beautiful British Columbia, Canada! The trip begins at the Toronto airport (get yourself there), and we'll fly to Vancouver non-stop. We'll spend six nights at the Listel Hotel right in the center of the wonderful ski village. Ski up to 5 days at the massive Whistler/Blackcomb (EPIC) resort, about 2.5 hours north of Vancouver. Lower elevations make for moderate temperatures and no altitude worries. Then a final overnight in downtown Vancouver, with an afternoon and evening to explore this fabulous city on your own. https://www.whistlerblackcomb.com/



Your Trip Includes:

- Round-trip airfare from Toronto to Vancouver on Air Canada (10am departure, may change)
 Overnight at Toronto airport the night before is on your own. Options shared w group soon.
- Bus to and from Vancouver to Whistler (about 2.5 hours north)
- 6 nights at the Listel Hotel centrally located in the ski village near the lifts, restaurants, bars, etc.

- Midweek happy hour and/or pizza party and group breakfast the final day (Friday) before loading the bus back to Vancouver (both TBD)
